Fundraising results from 2020 were stronger than expected.





Fundraising Effectiveness Project and Giving Tuesday

2020 Overall Results

- Giving is up in 2020 over Q1, Q2, & Q3 in 2019
- New donor acquisition up 11.4% and donations up 7.6%
- Largest increase in percentage of revenue coming from donors giving less than \$250: 17%

Giving Tuesday

- 25% increase in giving compared to 2019
- 29% in number of donations compared to 2019



Tell Us About Colorado Gives Day?



- \$50 million dollars were raised by and for Colorado Nonprofits on Colorado Gives Day
- More than 225,440 donations were made to 2,828 organizations
- Donation amounts ranged from \$5-\$200,000

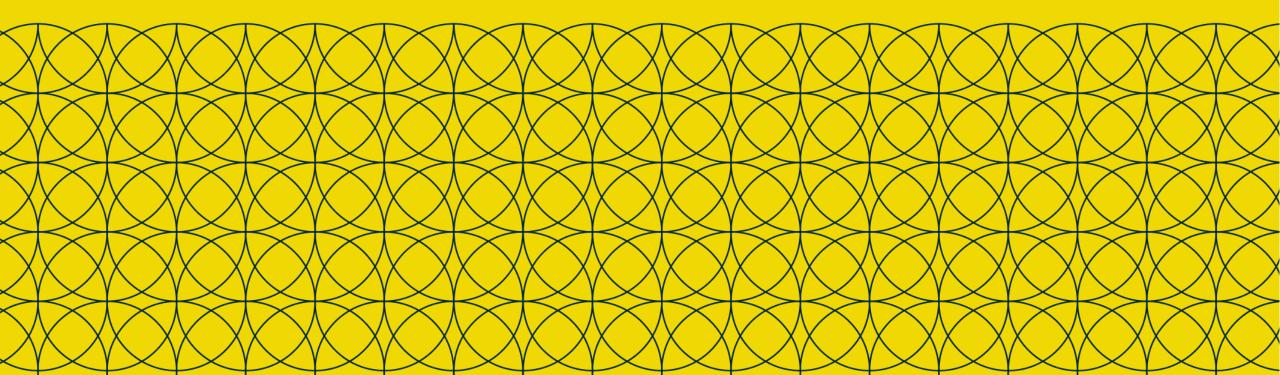


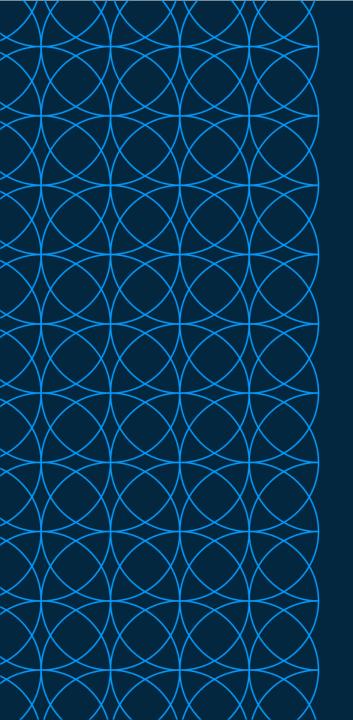
